SETTING UP YOUR PROFILE


An email will be sent to your registered email address with a URL that provides you access to the platform. You are then required to create an account and set up your profile.

Please follow the steps below to set up your profile once an account is created.

STEP ONE

In the top right-hand corner, under your profile, click on the dropdown and select Account. Once you are in the account section, under your profile details, you can edit your profile image, name, contact number, and designation.

We recommend registering the name and contact information of your school/classroom.



STEP 2

Once you have finished editing, click Update.



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AGENDA

You can access the event agenda by clicking on **Agenda** in the top menu. Click on your session of interest and you'll see a pop up card with the title, time and details of the session.


You can build your own itinerary by clicking on the **Calendar icon** and adding the session to your personal calendar. This can be done anytime from now up until the session goes live for each day of the event.

Please refer to the image below to see how the Join Session button appears, once the session is live.




When it's time to enter the session, simply click on the Join button.
