- Learn and Understand by** Reading about youth perspectives of reconciliation from the 2019 report, *Canadian Youth Reconciliation Barometer*.
- Explore by** Reading the Indigenous Youth Voices 2018 report, *A Roadmap to the TRC Call to Action # 66*.
- Recognize by** Acknowledging the work of groups like *Indigenous Youth Voices* and read their report on requirements for conducting research with and for Indigenous youth.
- Take action by** Reach out to MPs about the government’s commitment to the establishment of Indigenous Youth Voices as a permanent non-profit agency to inform, implement, and build on Call to Action #66.
- Teach by** Sharing information on Call to Action #66 and Indigenous Youth Voices.
