The grant funds are available to Indigenous communities, Survivor organizations, registered non-profits and others with community-led commemorative projects, gatherings and initiatives.

Communities and Survivors know what activities best support healing, memorials, and remembrance in their communities.

SOME IDEAS COULD INCLUDE:

- Memorial or commemorative markers
- Community-led healing gatherings
- Ceremonial activities

There is no deadline to apply.

Applications will be reviewed within six weeks of receipt.


